1 Arosa Train

Enjoy an exciting train ride with the Rhaetian Railway. From Chur, the capital of canton of Grisons, the train weaves its way along the sunny side of the Schanfigg valley. It passes steep rocks, lush forests and crosses the wild Plessur river on the elegant viaduct of Langwies. After a beautiful one-hour ride the train finally arrives at its final destination Arosa on 1,738 metres above sea level. Bear lovers and families adore the new bear wagon on the train between Chur and Arosa which was inaugurated in summer 2018. In addition the RhB (Rheatian Railway) is planning a bear safari to make the train ride even more entertaining.

This kids' paradise is located opposite the central waste collection point and the fire station at Kalkofenstrasse 45 and opens its doors daily from 2 pm to 6 pm (except on bright sunny days).

SummitBreakfast with 360° panoramic view

The day couldn't start any better: take the cable car from Arosa to the Weisshorn summit. The sumptuous "Summit Breakfast" in the 360 ° panoramic restaurant Weisshorngipfel with folk music can also be enjoyed as a pedestrian. The breathtaking mountain panorama is available for free. The ascent with the aerial cableway Arosa-Weisshorn is possible starting from 8.20 am, the Summit Breakfast can be enjoyed from 8.30 am to 11.00 am.

Squirrel Trail Exploration

The cute animals literally eat from your hand

The Squirrel trail is definitely the most popular themed route among families. The fluffy animals are coming up close and eat directly from the palm of your hand; enchanting young and old alike. The trail starts after crossing the Tomeli-Street (below the Waldhotel National) the path leads into the forest and ends at the bus stop Maran. Towards the end of the trail is a big playground with a barbecue area.



Riddle magazine and storybook

On the famous squirrel trail children can not only feed the cute animals, but also solve riddles along the way. Fun for tall and small. Pick up the exciting riddle magazine at the Arosa Tourist Office. In addition there are exciting stories on panels about squirrels and bears along the entire squirrel trail.

Besides squirrels the forest is a habitat for numerous birds who also like to be fed. Don't be afraid, not only the small sparrows and tits like to eat from your hand, but also the bigger nutcrackers like to come close and peck nuts from the palm of your hand.

Arosa - Litzirüti

The sledding and hiking trail from Arosa to Litzirüti meanders right through the middle of the pine forest . The trail follows the Plessur river and the tracks of the Rhaetian Railway. Every now and then fantastic views on the Schiesshorn, the Tjeier Flue and many more moutnains open up. Enjoy the return journey with a comfortable train ride from Litzirüti to Arosa (fee-based).

7 Honeyland

At the Prätschli, the "Honigland" creates a public and free beginner / children's snow sports area,. With a 45 m conveyor belt next to the Prätschli ski lift, the ski lift itself and various staging elements, a new world of experience has been created. Come and try it out! The topic "honey" is based on the Arosa Bear Sanctuary which is opened since August 2018.
